2107 changes

- Originally designed to address organic compounds for ozone - based on rule 66
- Specific sources addressed
- Exclusions from other rules and exemptions

2107 changes

- 2109 addresses VOC and 2107 addresses primarily OC.
- 2107 regulates PRM and liquid organic compounds that are baked, cured or heat polymerized

2107 Changes

- Removal of 8 lbs/hr, 40 lb/day requirement
- M(4) replaces G(1) Flame contact, heat cured
- M(3)g replaces G(2) Sheet mold compound

2107 changes

- Fed /State side of permit
- Sunset language
- Continue reporting

2107 changes

- What about BAT?
- SB 265
- Recalculation of PTE

STARS 2

- Quiet period – Starts May 2 in phases
- STARS2 goes live June 30
- Fee reports – will not be accepted in STARS1 after June 13 – Use Air Services after that

STARS 2

- PTI's and Title V permits stop – June 13
- Contingency plan for emergency issuance
- Compliance Certifications – Hard copy
